My name is Africa Coll and I'm a Spanish artist living in Sweden since 2001. I have studied at the Sant Jordi Fine Arts Faculty in the University of Barcelona, where my father was a professor (now retired). I have been in contact with art since my very first childhood. My first memories are playing in his studio, between his sculptures. The decision to become an artist was a natural choice, after having grown in such environment. I have also studied etching and papermaking in Jerusalem, Israel. Nowadays I work in my studio outside Lidköping and I have regular exhibitions in Sweden as well and in other countries. I work permanently with few galleries in Sweden: Galleri Art Veritas (Göteborg); Galeri Victoria (Göteborg); in Spain: Fecit (Sant Feliu de Guixols), GaleriaToranto (Barcelona), Sala Conca (Tenerife) and in Andorra: Galeria Art Vall

About my work

Since two years ago a big part of my work is related to trees/forest. I try to develop it in all the ways my experience takes me through.

I want to get a closer look at things. I want to be able to look at things. I want to be able to see things. This makes me understand them and at the same time, through them, I ask... I ask myself.

I work with the space between trees.... Is that the forest? What creates our idea of it? All what we don't see? All what is created in our way through it? Why do we choose to walk through? We create inexistent paths between the trees. We create the object where the object is absent. Is it an abstract vision of and inner illusion? Through all the reflections I get to a much more extensive and general subject.

I combine paintings, photographic works, sculptures, monotypes and texts to develop my relationship between me and my surroundings. We could say that this perceptual exploration leads to a poetical experience. I mainly question the relationship between space and object, space between objects, space that creates our idea of the surroundings.

I paint on canvas. Some of them are 120 x 40 cm and their start point is tree trunks. They can be hanged together, quite close, or around a high column (when the space is big enough) one in each side, giving the feeling that we walk through a forest. I work also in different sizes and with photo on painted aluminum. A part of the work consists in photography in aluminum which is also painted previously. I use different techniques as I'm very interested in experimentation. Most of those techniques are acrylic based, on canvas, aluminum or plexiglas.

I write my reflections on plexiglas that hang on the walls or just lie on the floor, between the trees. The empty part of the forest creates our vision of it. This is a little summary of my present work. I submit pictures and some of the texts.
