In my paintings I try to strike a balance between a reproduction which is painstakingly true and on the other hand abstract in nature. One doesn't need to see the whole story to be able to complete the image with one's own eyes. To recognize as such a landscape or an interior is important but within these limitations much is possible and I try to be receptive to spontaneous impulses. Lately I paint subjects in my immediate surroundings, at home, in my room, or out of the window. By way of painting the interaction of light and shadow and carefully position objects I try to avoid a certain predictability and to stimulate good viewing.
