The ceramic objects from Sonja van Dijk are organic, a little science-fiction like but specially colorful.

One of the characteristics of the objects is that there is always something new to discover. You can't but help to look around the object.

The color scene is reinforced by the alternation of the highgloss glaze with matt surface. One could think that this might push it over the top, but actually it brings a bit of calmness into it which allows to the colors to get more attention.

People see different things in the objects. But a common remark is that people get happy when looking at the objects.
